The Foundation acquired Tax Exempt Status in 1994 and is a nonprofit organization, Tax ID# 34-1751216. The Foundation reports to the IRS as a public charity using Form 990.

2022 DISTRIBUTION TO THE PENINSULA LIBRARY & HISTORICAL SOCIETY

As responsible stewards of the Foundation's resources and to fulfill its mission, a Distribution Policy was formulated to allow the investment to grow while making a steady amount available for distribution to the Peninsula Library & Historical Society on an annual basis. The Foundation uses a calculation to determine the funds offered to the library in a given year.

In 2022, the Foundation offered the library an amount of \$21,910 which was accepted and distributed in full. In twelve annual disbursements, since 2010, the Foundation has distributed a total of \$178,905 to the Peninsula Library & Historical Society.

PENINSULA LIBRARY FOUNDATION ACTIVITES 2022

The Foundation received \$125,517.77 in donations during 2022.

The Foundation's Operating Expenses amounted to \$9,702.

Calculated at 25 basis points of the portfolio value, \$15,857.96. was retained by Lincoln Investment for its services as of December 31, 2022. The fees charged to the investment account equal approximately .9% of the December 31, 2022 account balance.
